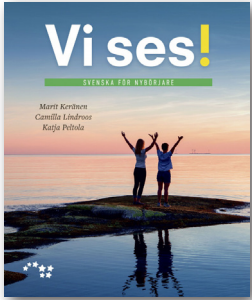


SWEDISH FOR BEGINNERS

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

After this course you will have reached **level A1** on the European language scale (CEFR) which means that you will be able to:

- understand and use common expressions and basic phrases for day-to-day situations
- introduce yourself and engage in simple conversation about where you live, people you know and things you have around you
- understand and engage in simple small talk at a reasonably slow pace
